The Epistles: The laws of scientific Christianity Study Assignment

Preparation:

- a) Each student should become acquainted in a general way with the book, *The Epistles in the Light of Christian Science*.
- b) Pages 1–39 define the difference between the old and the new covenant, between "the law" and "the faith". This difference should be grasped spiritually in a clear and definite way.
- c) The focus on our discussion will be on the Christianity-matrix, explained on pages 40–44 and 239–253.
- d) Since "Hebrews" has a very complex structure, we cannot go into details but will consider only the overall structure, as I have summarized it in the matrix on page 166.
- e) Some of the Epistles have subtone-epitomes. They are given to substantiate the maintone-epitomes, but we will not have time to discuss them at the seminar.

Assignment:

- 1) briefly discuss the concept "matrix" and its purpose, recapitulating your study of this subject from *A Study Aid for the Science of Christian Science*, page 96;
- 2) discuss the Christianity-matrix:
 - the spiritual meaning of the index i,
 - the spiritual meaning of the index j,
 - the spiritual meaning of the 16 points of intersection (the Epistles as a whole);
- 3) read some Epistles for exercising text-interpretation;
- 4) show how we can define the "standpoint" and "law" of each Epistle;
- 5) exercise the "scientific law" of some Epistles.
