Mind (as a symbol conveys)

- infinite Mind is the basis of reality.

Spirit (as a symbol conveys)

- The infinite Mind is the only reality.
- Substance is idea, a Mind formation, not matter.

Soul (as symbol conveys)

- The infinite Mind constitutes our true unchangeable identity.
- All faculties of seeing, hearing, tasting, touching, and smelling are faculties of Mind, not body.

physical

Metaphysics: the contemplation of ideas

- 1. All is mental (cogito, ergo sum)
- 2. The mental can be good or evil
- 3. Thinking in terms of ideas
- 4. Thinking in terms of the synonyms for God

Science: the contemplation of the infinite One, including all ideas

- 5. Only the synonyms for God in us can be one with synonym for God
- 6. Life, Truth, and Love is the only "I" of us
- 7. The synonyms for God are the only "I" or Ego

Notes on Handling the Seven Root Errors (reference: Notes on Handling Evil with References from the Work of Mary Baker Eddy, by Max Kappeler)

- 1. The necessity of handling the 7 root errors [evil].
- 2. The nothingness of nothing must be understood.
- 3. Error in all its forms must be reduced to its native nothingness.
- 4. Understanding the nothingness of the 7 root errors demonstrates the somethingness of Mind, Spirit, Soul, Principle, Life, Truth, and Love—the 7 root facts.
- 5. Ignorance about the 7 root errors is an error in itself.
- 6. Understanding the nothingness of the 7 root errors and the allness of Mind, Spirit, Soul, Principle, Life, Truth, and Love holds error in check.
- 7. Protection against error is necessary.
- 8. Error and Truth are not two.
 - a) The 7 root errors are only a negative definition of Mind, Spirit, Soul, Principle, Life, Truth, and Love.
 - b) The 7 root errors are counterfeits of Mind, Spirit, Soul, Principle, Life, Truth, and Love.
 - c) The 7 root errors simulate Mind, Spirit, Soul, Principle, Life, Truth, and Love.
 - d) The 7 root errors are supposititious¹ opposites of Mind, Spirit, Soul, Principle, Life, Truth, and Love.
 - e) The 7 root errors are supposititious antipodes² of Mind, Spirit, Soul, Principle, Life, Truth, and Love.
 - f) The 7 root errors are an inversion of Mind, Spirit, Soul, Principle, Life, Truth, and Love.
- 9. The 7 root errors serve as a waymark for Mind, Spirit, Soul, Principle, Life, Truth, and Love.
- 10. The suppositional origin of the 7 root errors
